

Note for Passengers Traveling NYANG 109th Flights to Greenland

Effective March 2010

- No Shuttle Service between Albany Airport and Hotels

The Hampton Inn and Holiday Inn no longer offer a shuttle service to/from the airport, so you will need to take a taxi. The shuttle is still available for grocery runs and other errands within ~5 mile radius of the hotel.

- Taxis No Longer Allowed at Stratton ANG Base

Taxis are no longer permitted on the base, not even through the lower gate. However, if you have a personal car, you may park it at Stratton.

- Flight-Morning Bus Transport to Stratton ANG Base

The ANG will provide a bus to pick you up with stops at the Holiday Inn AND the Hampton Inn. Please be in the lobby with all your luggage at **5:00 a.m.**

If you are staying at a hotel other than the Holiday Inn or Hampton Inn, you will need to walk or take a taxi to the Holiday Inn or Hampton by 5.00 a.m.

- Before You Leave Your Home Airport

Before departure, please provide your cell phone number and the hotel you'll be staying in to your PI or your Project Manager in case we need to contact you in NY.

- Food for Flight

It's a good idea to bring a lunch or something to eat on the flight as no food is provided. The flight can take 6-7 hrs en-route to Greenland with a likely stop for fuel at Goose Bay, Newfoundland.
